- 24 colored snowflake cards

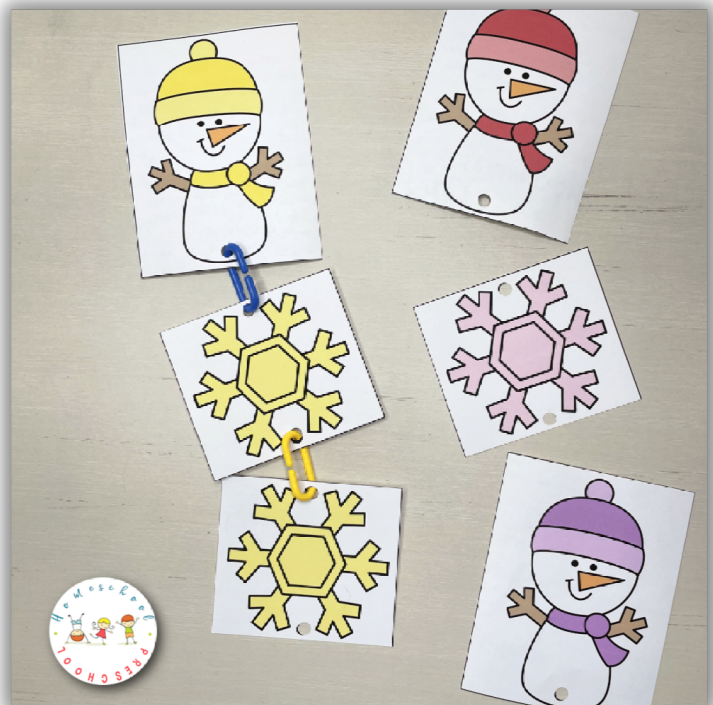
To prepare the activity, print the cards on cardstock and laminate before cutting apart the cards. Use a hole punch to punch holes on each black dot.

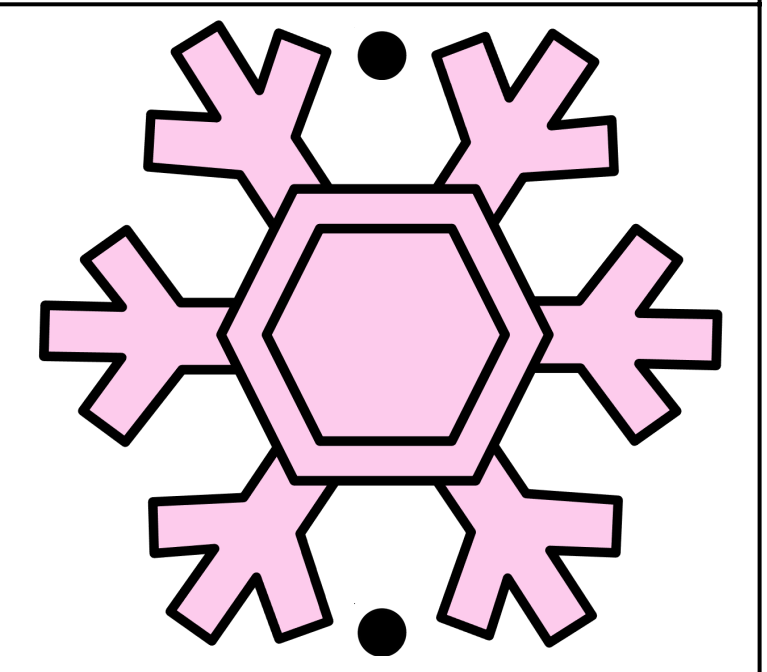
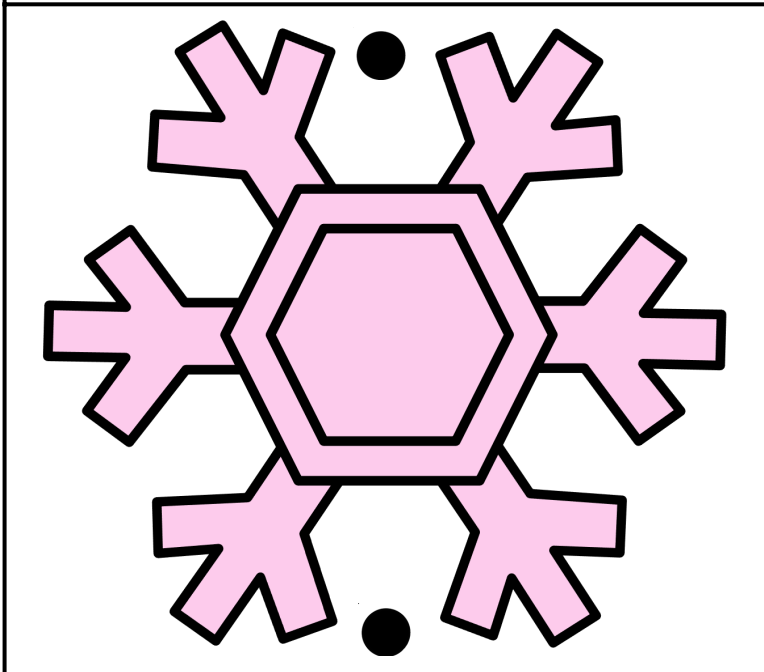
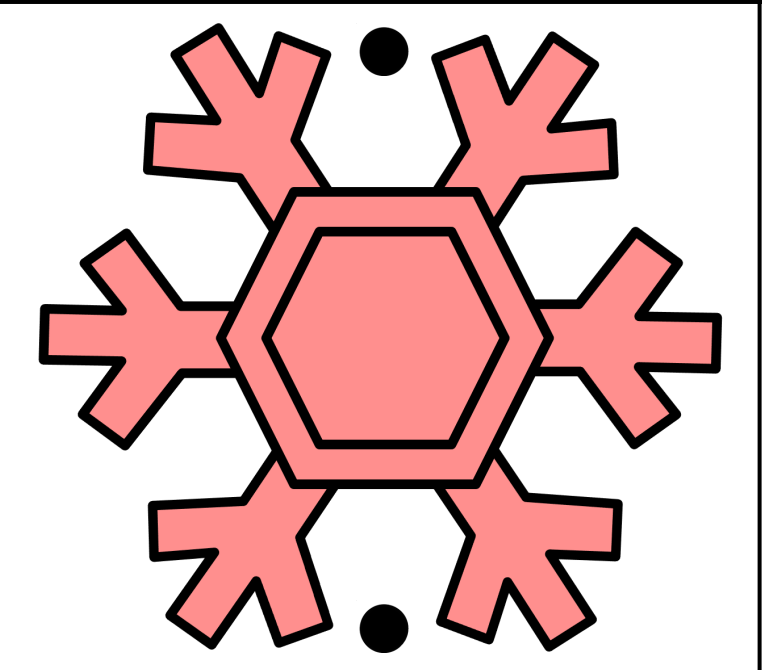
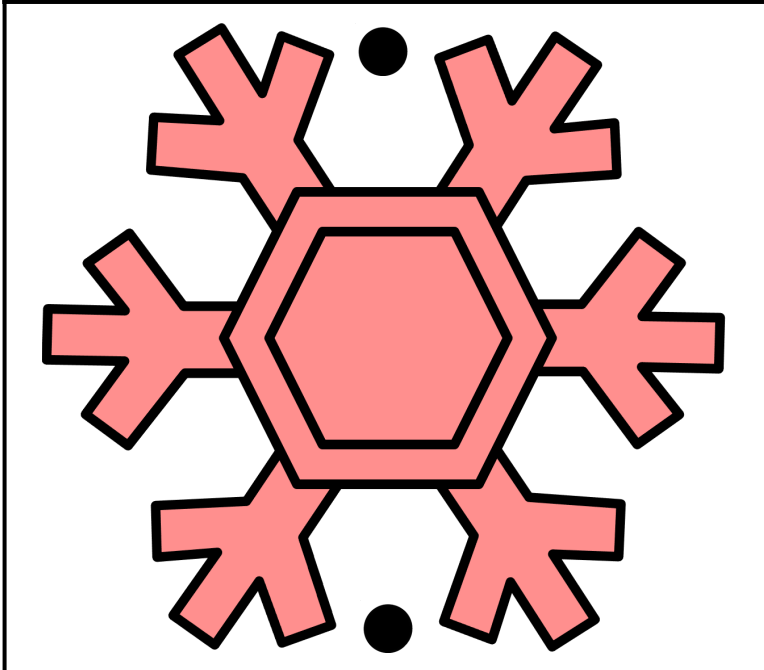
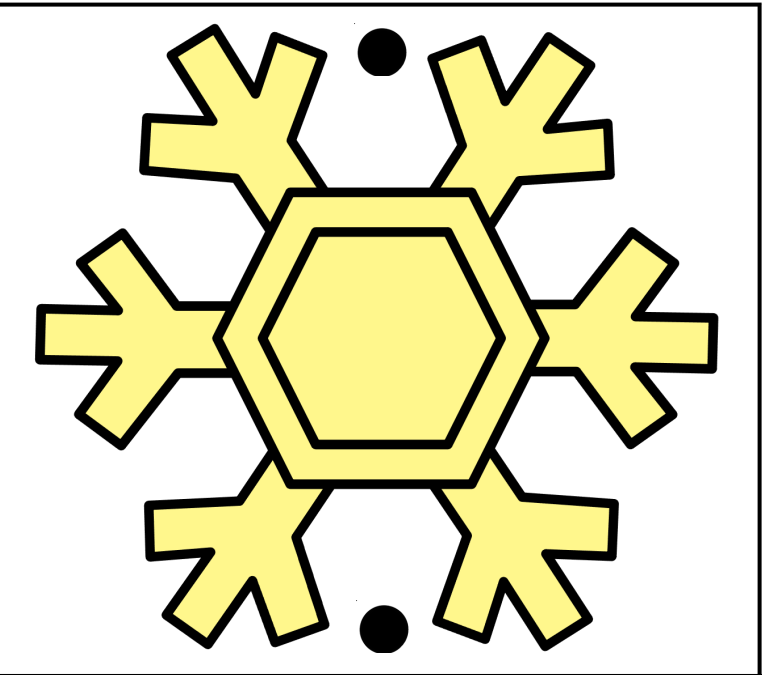
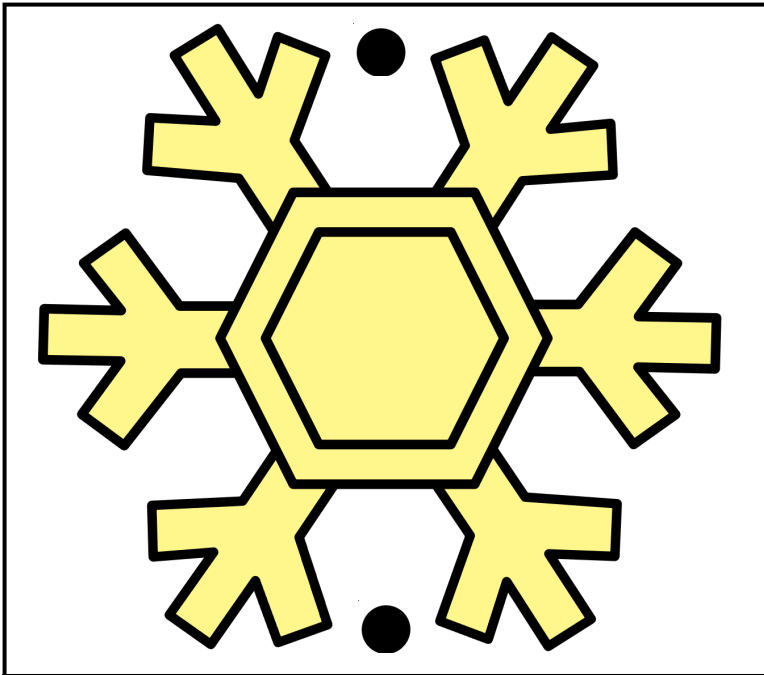
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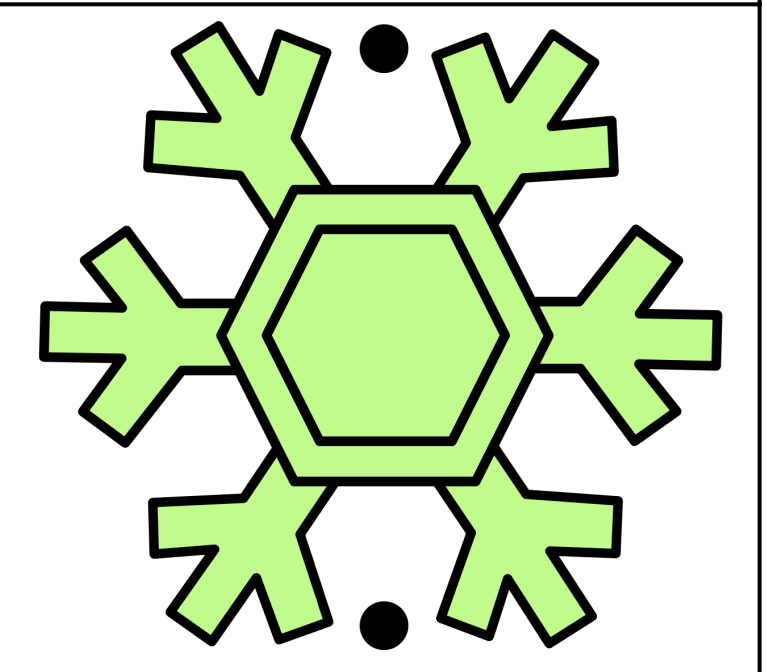
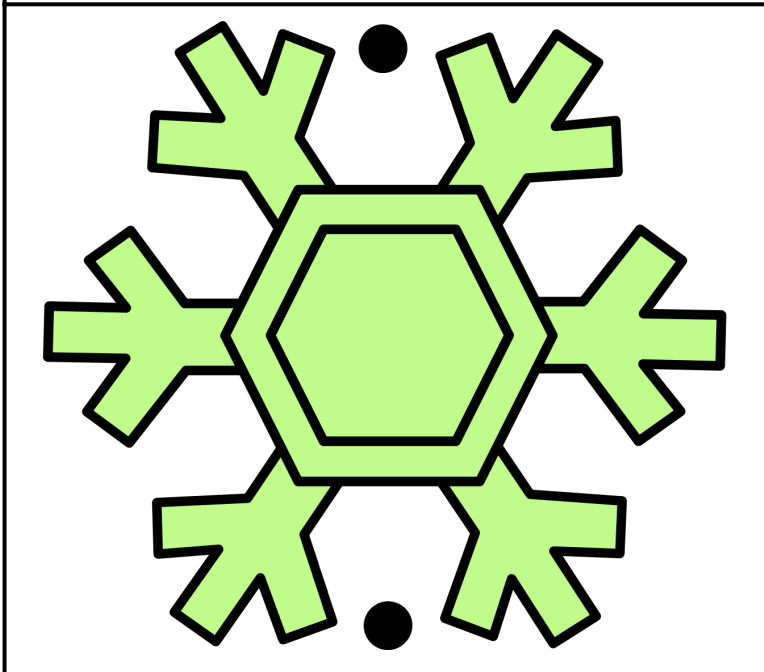
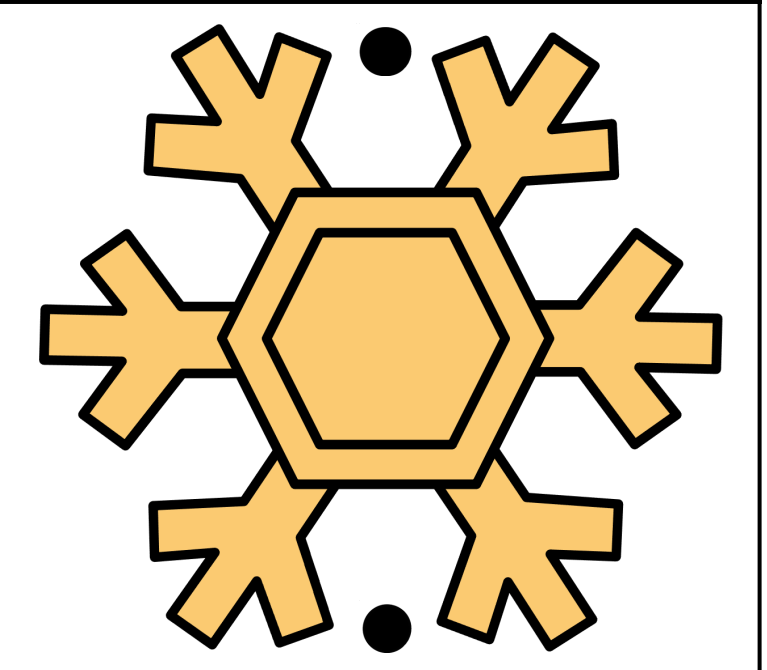
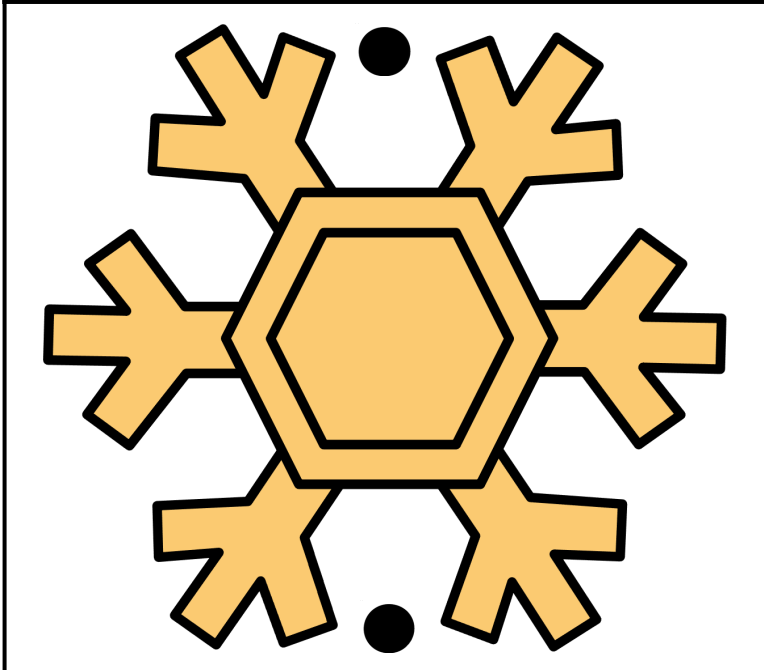
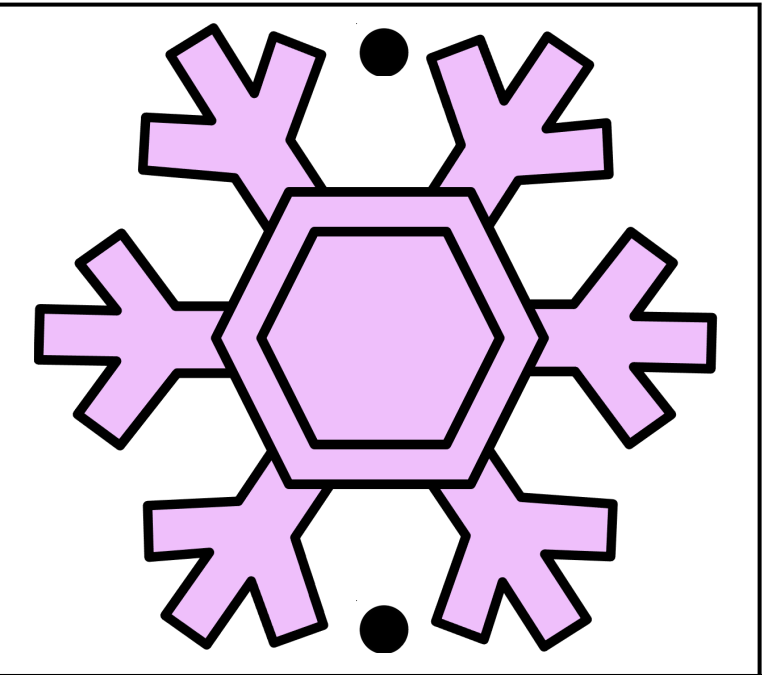
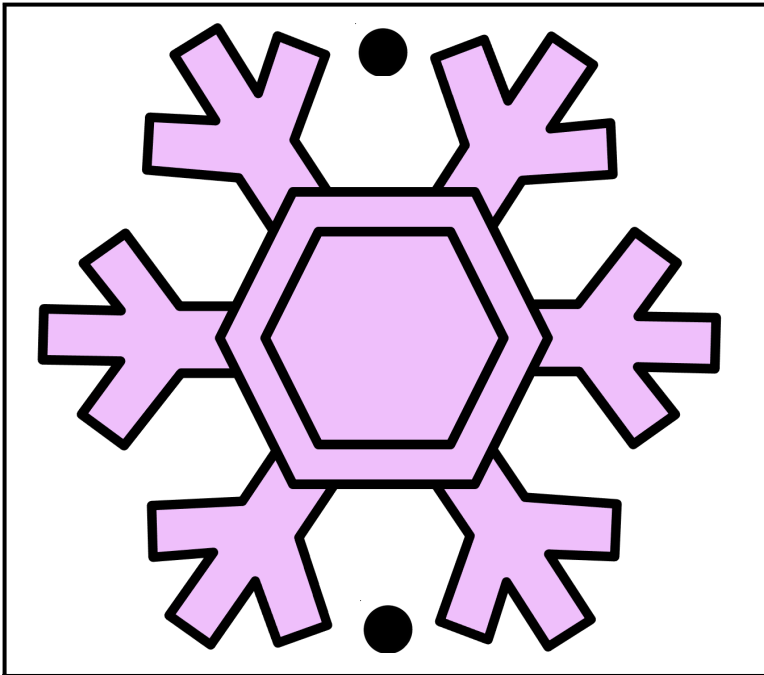

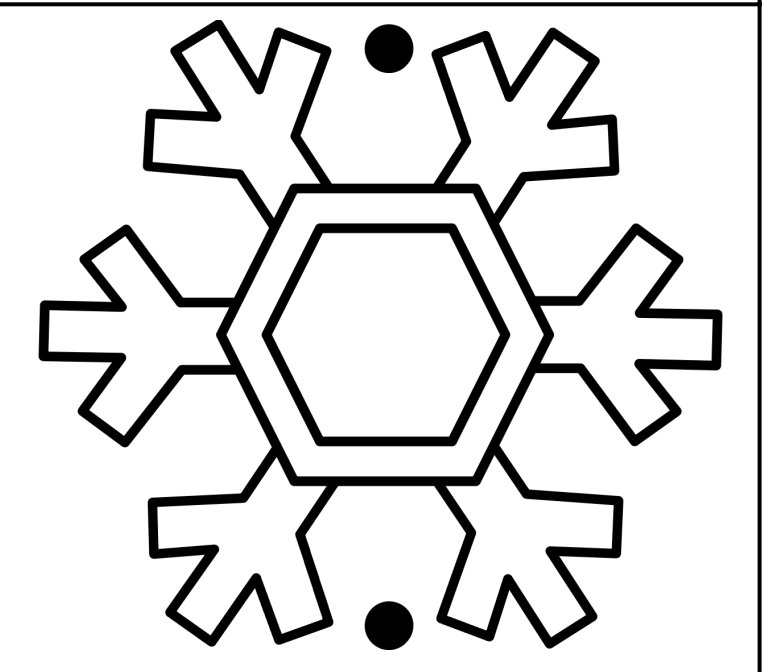
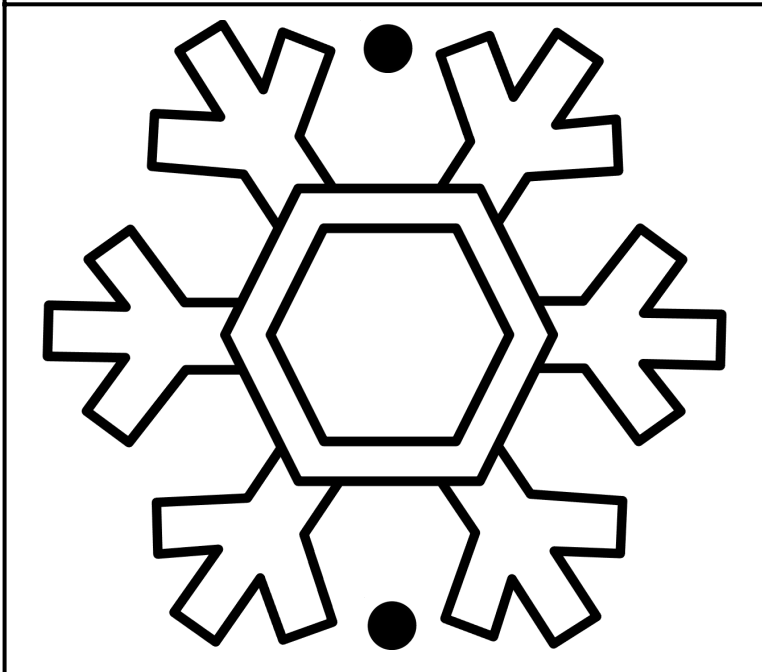
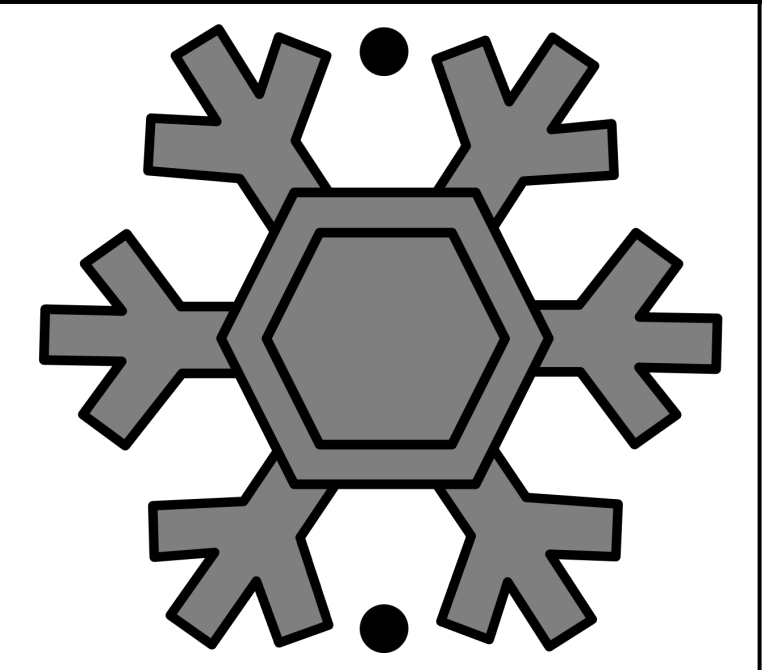
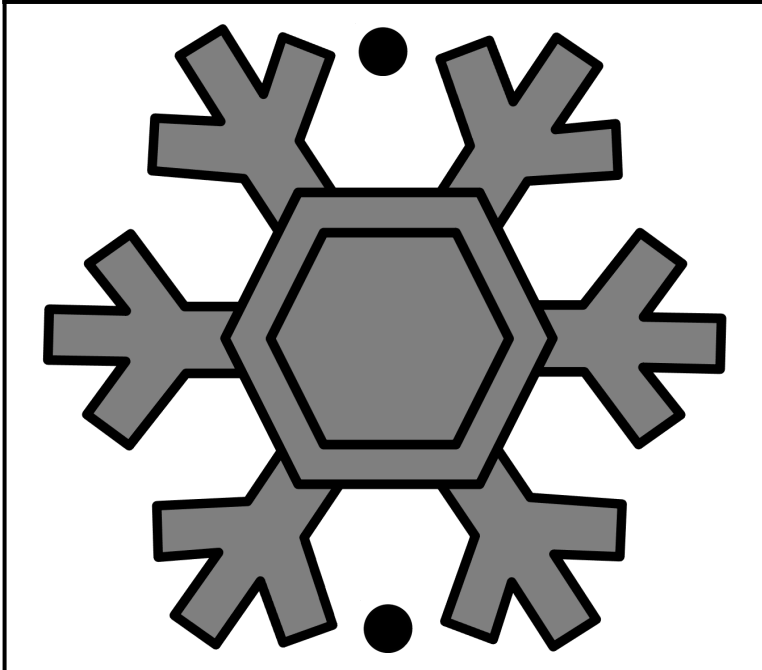
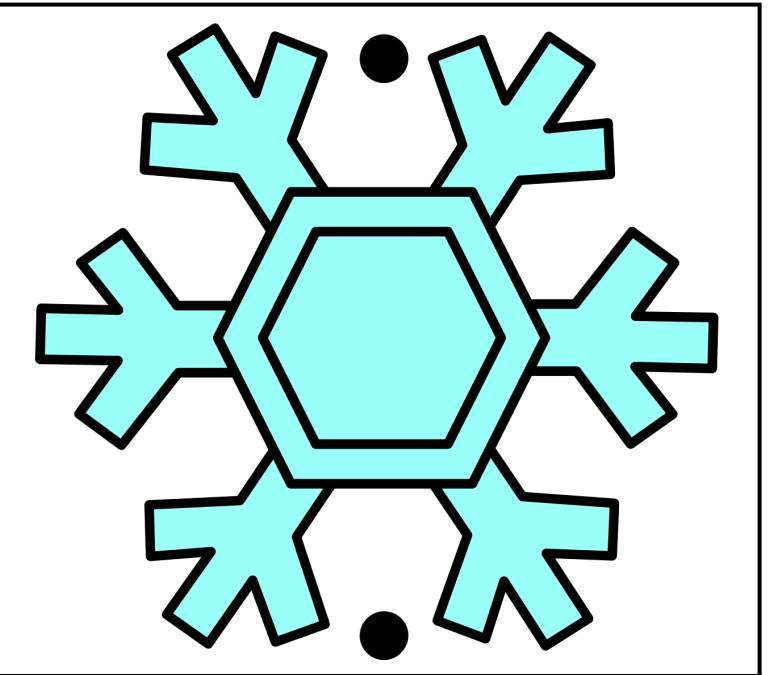
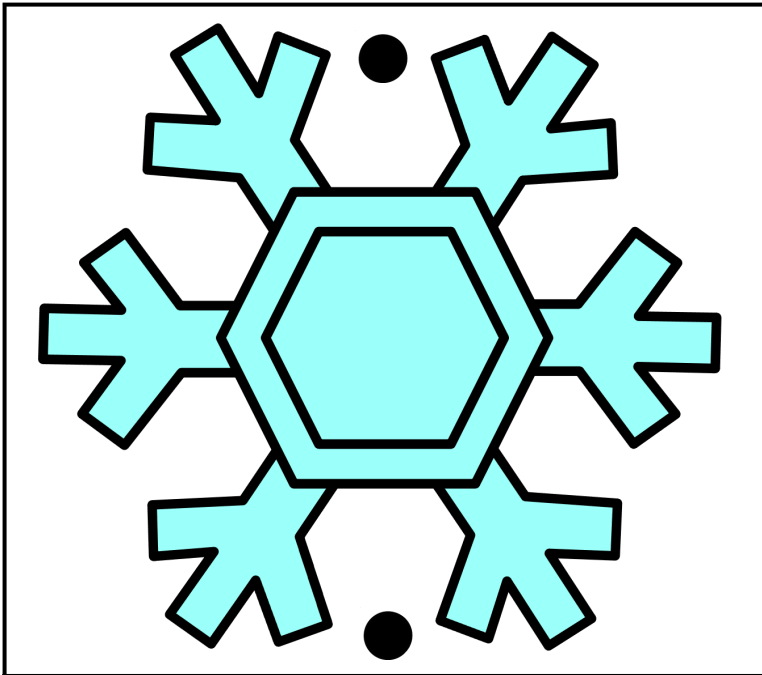
Have students choose a snowman. Sort through the snowflakes to find two that are the same color. Use links to connect the snowman and matching snowflakes.

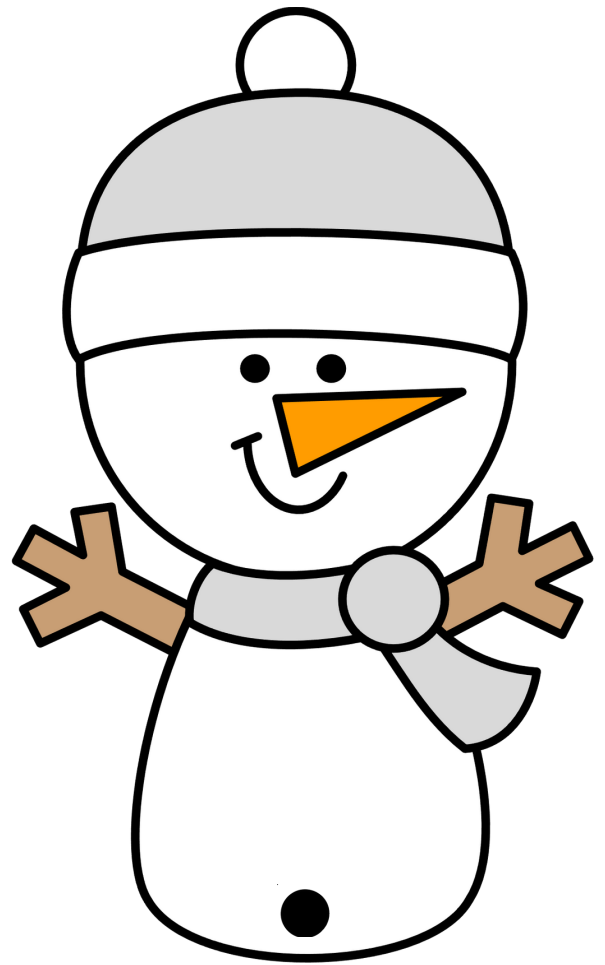


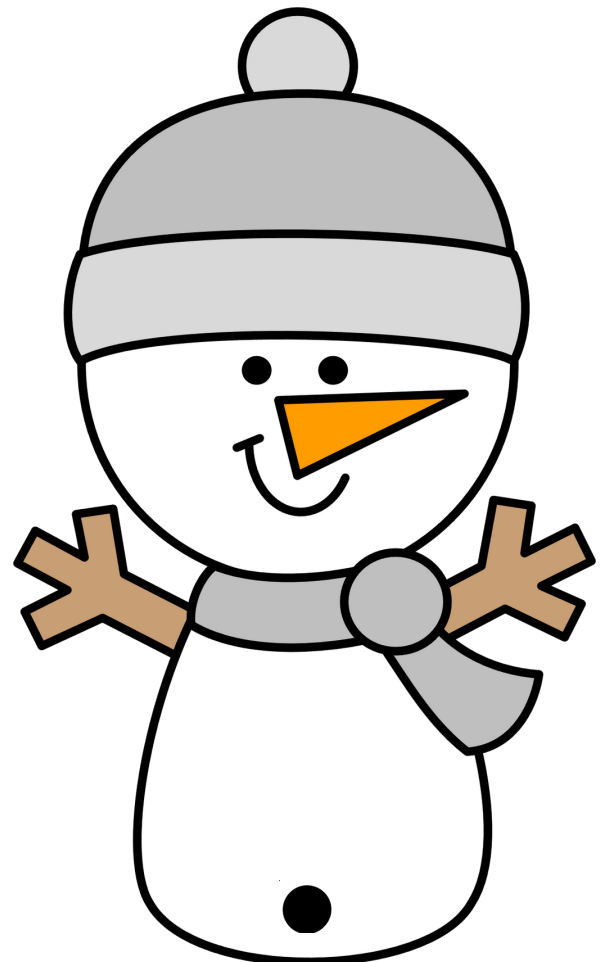














Snowman Counting

This snowman counting activity is a great way for children to practice number recognition and counting to 10.

What's Included

- 1 snowman mat
- 10 snowflake number cards (1-10)

Preparing the Activity

To prepare the activity, print the pages on cardstock and laminate before cutting apart the number cards.

Additional Supplies:

- buttons

Completing the Activity

Have student choose a snowflake card and identify the number. Then, have them count that many buttons and place them on the snowman.







Winter Alphabet Trace

This alphabet activity is perfect for helping children practice letter recognition and letter formation.

What's Included

- 26 uppercase letter cards
- 26 lowercase letter cards
- 1 uppercase tracing page

Preparing the Activity

Print the pages on cardstock and laminate for durability. Cut apart the letter cards. You could also slip the tracing pages in a dry erase pocket.

Additional Supplies:

Completing the Activity

Students will choose a card and identify the letter on it. Then, they'll find that letter on the tracing page and trace it. You can have kids match lowercase/lowercase, lowercase/uppercase, uppercase/uppercase, or uppercase/lowercase.

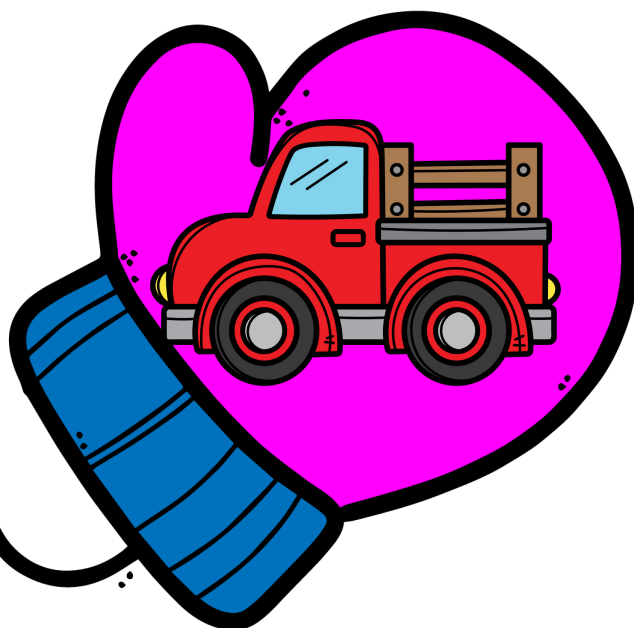
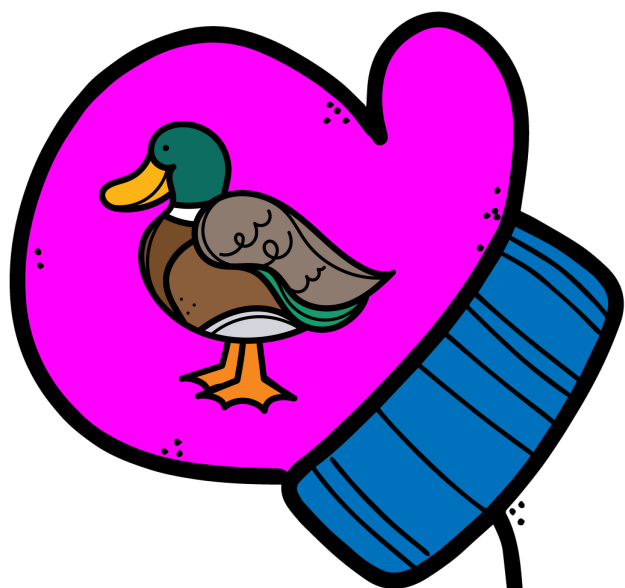
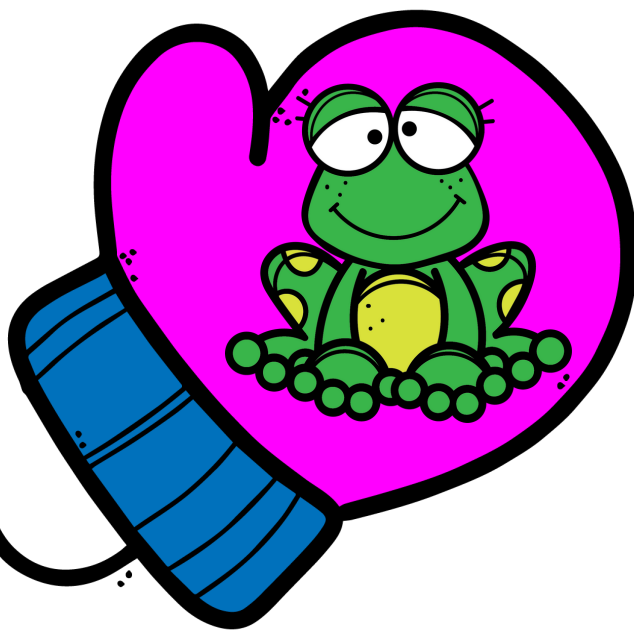
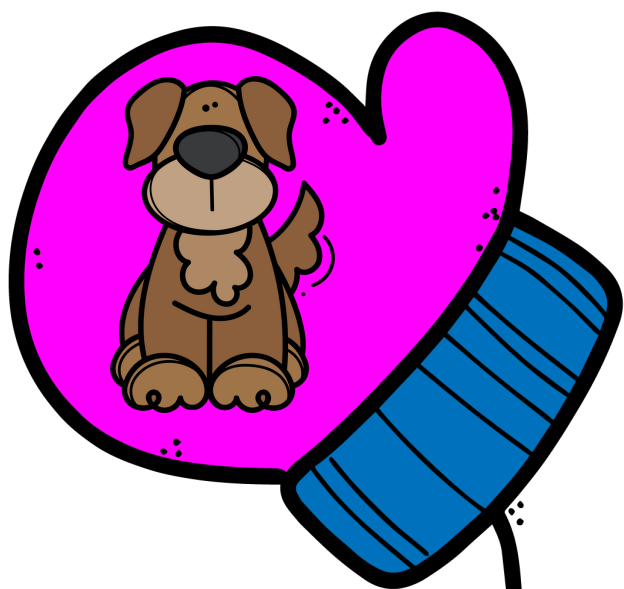
Students will match the mittens that rhyme. You can add a fine motor element to this activity by punching holes in each set and having students use plastic links to connect the rhymes.

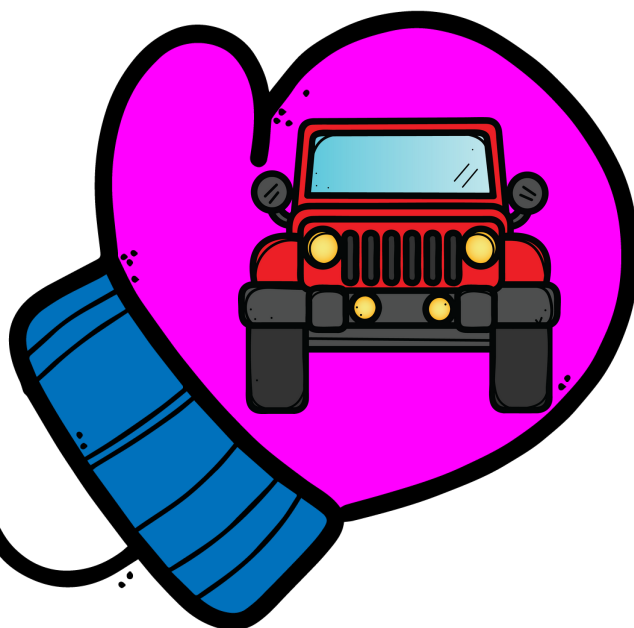
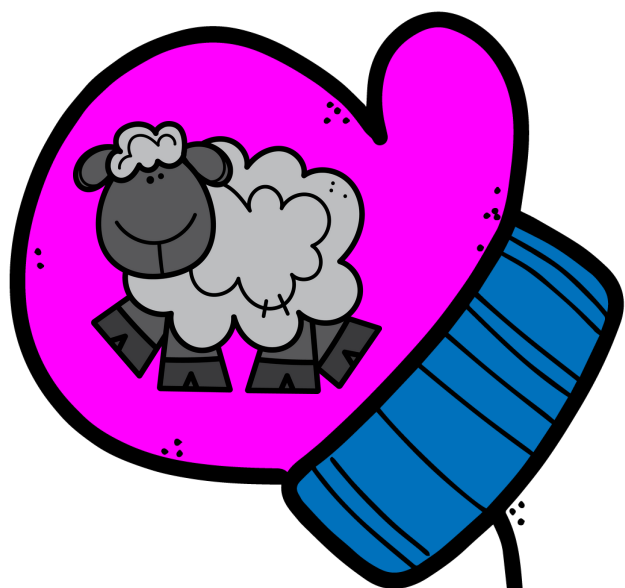
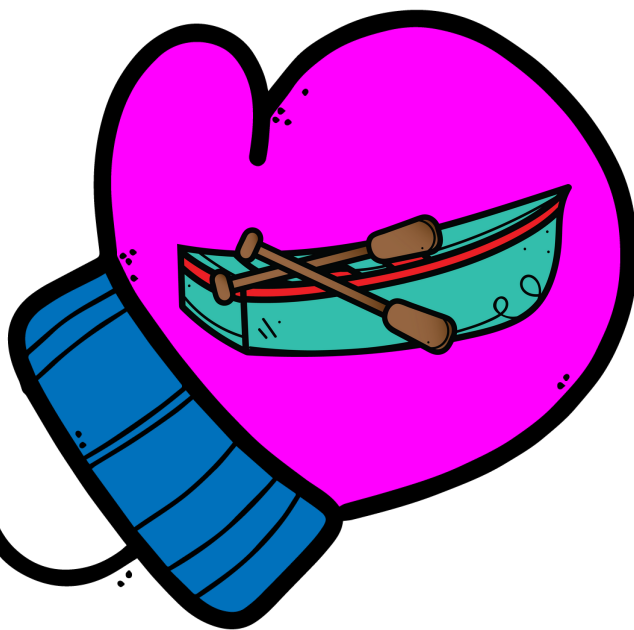
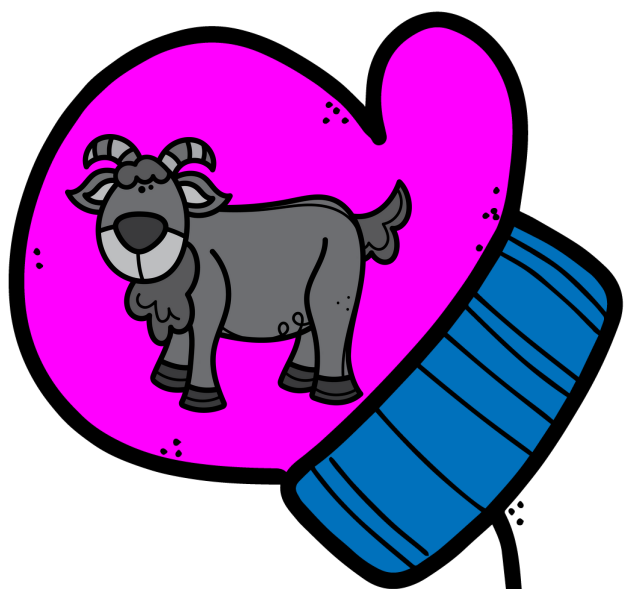

Print the pages on cardstock and laminate for durability. Cut apart the alphabet cards.

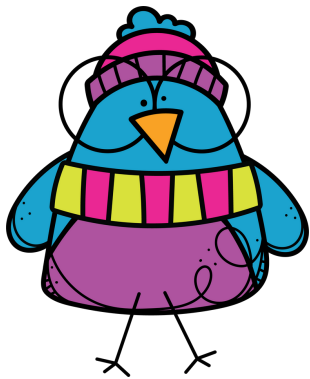

Additional Supplies:

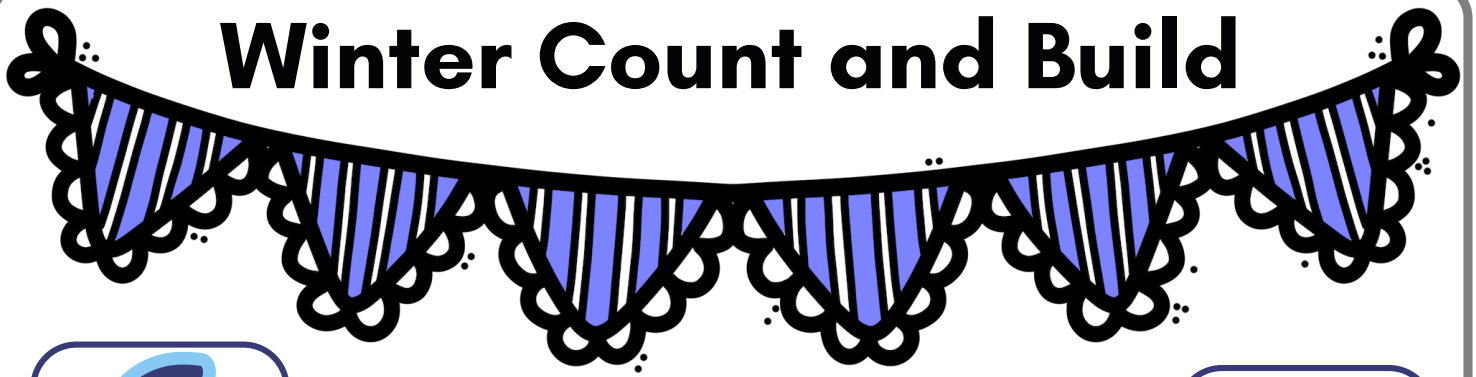
- snap cubes

- velcro dots (optional)

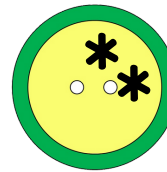
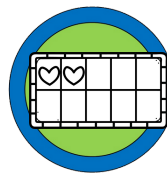
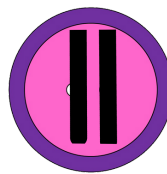
